

# Glynnis Reed

Born in Los Angeles, California, Glynnis Reed currently lives and works as a professor of photography in Southern New Jersey. Ms. Reed's work explores identity and place and the complexities of one's relationship with the self and with others. She often engages narratives of love and loss, shadow and light. Her work moves between a search into the urban landscape to the spaces where city meets nature and how such spaces affect the human psyche. Much of the photography she uses in her work has been collected in public parks and museums throughout the world.

She exhibits her work throughout the country and has been shown in solo and group exhibitions at salffineart + RAWsalt in Laguna Beach since 2015.
